Policy Working Group, subcommittee of Clackamas County's TSP Public Advisory Committee, to meet Thursday, April 5

The first of six subcommittees -- or working groups -- of the Clackamas County Transportation System Plan (TSP) Public Advisory Committee will hold its first meeting on Thursday, April 5.
