




## Tumalo Active Transportation Initial Concept Plan

#### Safety & Speed Improvements:

- Roundabout at Cline Falls Hwy and Tumalo Rd
- Raised intersection at Cook Ave/4<sup>th</sup> St (interim)
- Widen shoulders on Tumalo Rd from the Deschutes River bridge to Swalley Rd
- Widen shoulders on Cline Falls Hwy from Tumalo Rd to Highland Dr
- Implement dynamic speed warning signs on Cline Falls
   Hwy and Tumalo Rd
- Enhanced Entry statement at Cline Falls Hwy/Tumalo Road














## Speed Control & Intersection Improvements

Roundabout draft concept at Cline Falls Highway/ Tumalo Road






## Tumalo Active Transportation Initial Concept Plan

#### **Pedestrian Connectivity:**

- Sidewalk on both sides of Bruce Ave (prioritize east side)
- Sidewalk/multi-use path on west side of Wharton Ave
- Continue pedestrian facilities north of 4<sup>th</sup> St to 2<sup>nd</sup> St on both sides
- Wayfinding for a walking loop in Tumalo
  - This would be an effort led by the community
- Reconsider trail from Tumalo-to-Tumalo State Park

- Bruce Ave Stop
- Country Store (5<sup>th</sup> St) Stop

Raised intersection (Cook & 4 <sup>th</sup> )
