

### Project Background:

- Two-part project:
  - Sisters Country Trails Expansion Outreach
  - Tumalo Community Plan Active Transportation Update
- Tumalo Health Impact Assessment (2008)
- Tumalo Community Plan (2010); update underway
- Deschutes County Transportation Systems Plan (2012); update underway
- New businesses supporting a community downtown for Tumalo
- CET's 2040 Master Plan identifies future transit stop in Tumalo
- State Scenic Bikeway (Twin Bridges Route)



#### What will this project accomplish?

- Identify gaps/concerns in the Tumalo biking and walking system (called "Active Transportation")
- Reach out to Tumalo residents, business owners, and other stakeholders about bicycling, walking, and transit needs
- Create a list/map of needed active transportation projects in Tumalo
- Provide amendments to the TCP and County TSP to implement the recommendations









#### Background: Tumalo Health Impact Assessment (2008)

The THIA identified the following three policy areas:

- Safety/accessibility of Highway 20 for all users
- Need for a multi-modal trail system
- Access to recreational amenities



#### Background: Tumalo Community Plan (TCP) Update

- Update changes in Tumalo since 2010: population, number of developed lots, types of land uses, and traffic volumes
- Discuss the Community Vision should "retain Tumalo's livability and feel as a rural small town" be maintained or modified?
- Seek public input on major topics such as land use, potential sewer system, open space and recreation, transportation, etc.



- Potential roundabout or realignment












