## **Draft TSP Policy Working Group Discussion Topics and Meeting Schedule**

### **Overview**

- The overall policy discussion framework is established by the **State TSP** (Oregon Transportation System Plan and related sub-plans) and the State of Oregon **Transportation Planning Rule** (TPR).
- The policy discussion framework for the portion of the county within the Metro Boundary, which is larger than the Metro Urban Growth Boundary in some places, is set by the **Regional Transportation Plan** (RTP) and **Regional Transportation Functional Plan** (RTFP). The RTFP identifies a number of requirements that local government must include in an updated TSP.
